New Initiatives

• Deacon's Mission for August: Pyle Center Emergency Fund - The Pyle Center Emergency Fund is the Deacon's monthly mission for the month of August. The process for securing funds from the Emergency Fund is as follows:

A Pyle Center social worker completes a form that is sent to the Ministerium Emergency Fund. Funds are used primarily for rent, utilities, and/or medical expenses. Funds cannot be used for food purchases. Regulations require that subsidies not exceed \$500 and can only be requested once per year per family. The budget for the Emergency Fund is developed through donations and Grants.
